

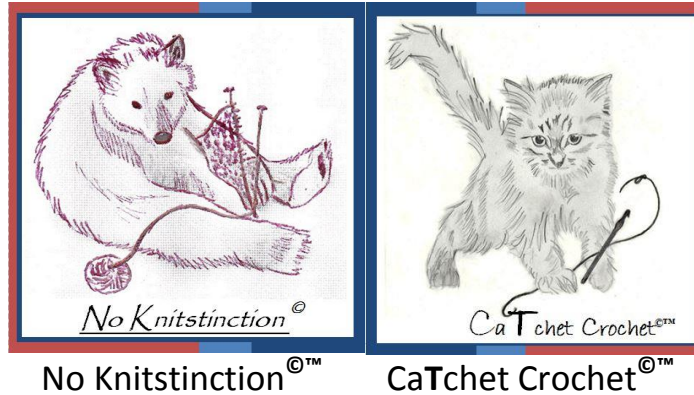
How to Count I-Cord Loops

Photo above is at completion of step 4 in directions.

Red pin at left is at beginning knot.

1. Green arrows: at first set of lps, one on ea side of vertical bar
2. Blue arrows: at ea set of two sts on ea side.
3. photo at right: 12 sets of lps completed.
4. Every two turns equal one set of lps.
5. If the total required were 12 sets, per photo cut yarn, pull lp thru (do not do a ch st before pulling thru)
